The **Care Ministry** is housed in a building behind Main Street Church in southern Campbell County. What an enthusiastic group of people! Here are some facts about their work.

- Distribute food, clothing, household items, and baby furniture
- Distribute Government commodities (no need to go to Brighton Center)
- Serve approximately 100 families in the city of Alexandria
- Serve 10 counties - close by and including as far away as Robertson, Bracken, Mason, and Hamilton (Ohio) - basically they have a "Don't Turn Anyone Away" policy

That's what THEY do! What can WE do for them?

****We can help supply personal items** that can't be purchased with food stamps. **Alexandria United Methodist Church's mission is to help the Care Ministry by supplying deodorant, toothpaste, shampoo, and bar soap.** As soon as we take items in they immediately place them on the shelf. The volunteers appreciate being able to offer personal items to the families.

****We can donate food any time.**

****We can also volunteer our time.** You already know one of the caring volunteers -**Greg Rath**. You may also see some of your neighbors and friends. The Care Ministry is open Tuesdays 9am-2pm and 6pm-8pm, Thursdays 9am-2pm, Saturdays 9am-noon. Volunteers can help with interviewing families. You would be trained with the software used. You might work sorting clothing or stocking shelves. Interested volunteers can call ahead to set up a time to walk through the facility and shadow another volunteer or be trained on the software. They welcome anyone interested in the Ministry to just stop by.

Your donated deodorant, toothpaste, shampoo, and bar soap can be placed in the container with the sign under the table in the foyer any time.
